Clap, clap, clap your hands as slowly as you can Clap, clap, clap your hands as quickly as you can (repeat with shake, pound, roll your hands, and pat your face)

TIPS:

- ◆ Older children inevitably make a big deal of patting their faces hard, saying "ow!" each time. So be ready for their silliness!
- When you sing this with infants and very young children, be aware of how quickly they are able to manipulate their hands and try not to get ahead of them.
