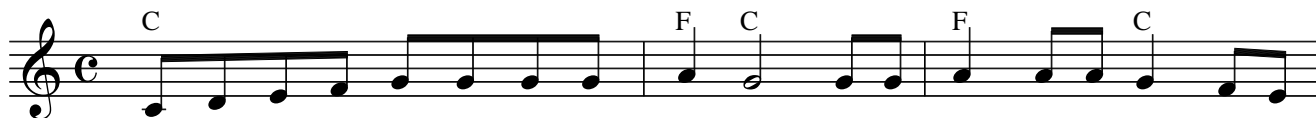


Once Upon a Time
