

Wheels

Think of as many other wheeled things as you can, and add your own verses:

EXAMPLES: Dump truck, unicycle, trailer, roller skates, baby stroller, grocery cart

For younger children, hold up pictures as you sing. (Printed on the following pages.)

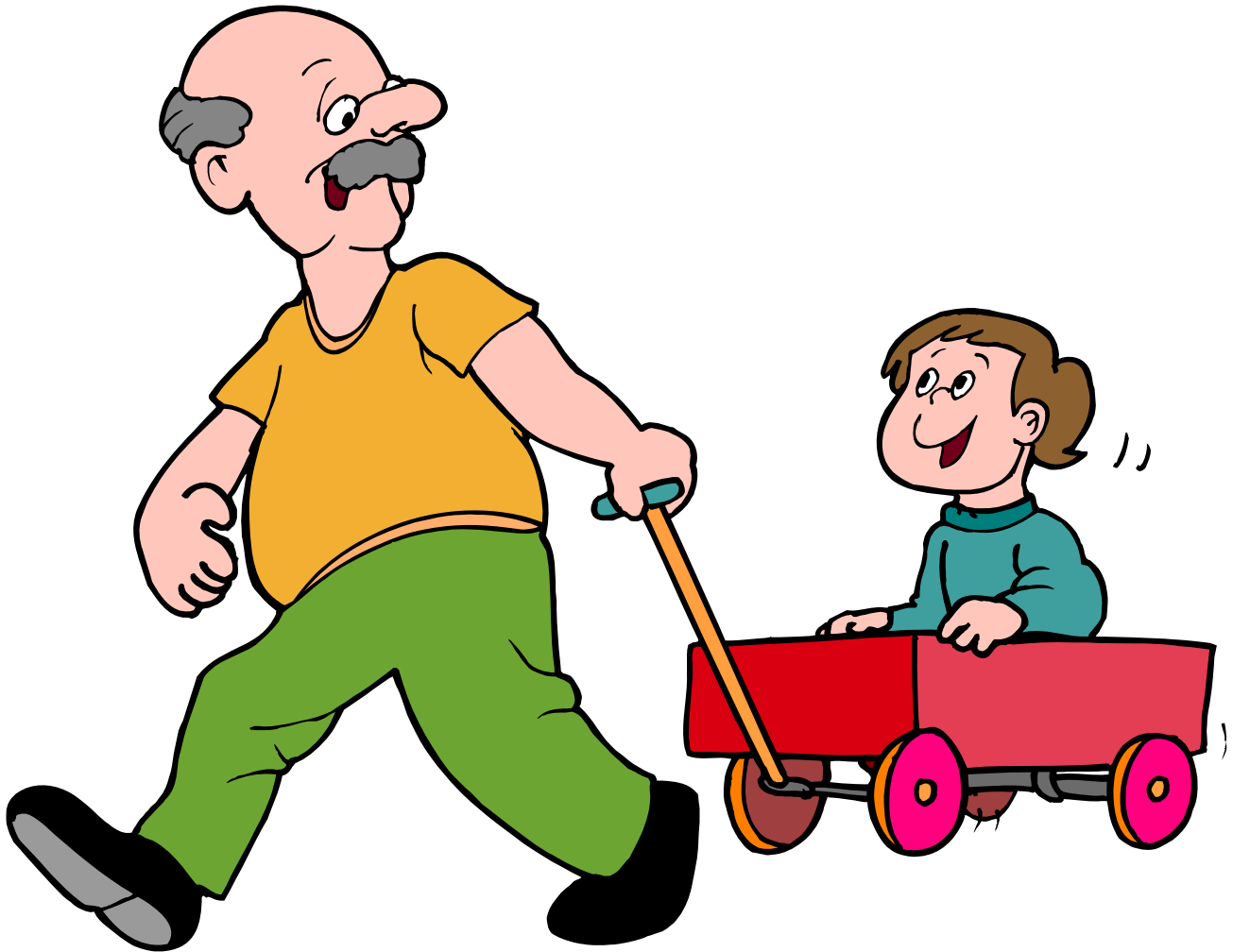
